



Read a description of a character or setting



#### Rainbowing activity

2Pt3 Explore number problems and puzzles


Today is Junior's Granny's birthday. She is younger than 60 but older than 50.


- Clue 1: If you add the digits in Granny's age, you get an even number.
- Clue 2: Both of the digits in Granny's age are odd.
- ▶ Clue 3: The two digits in Granny's age are different.
- Clue 4: If you add the digits in Granny's age, you get a 2-digit number with next-door digits.

How old is Granny?
